

Help Keep Oak Island Safe & Clean

In our effort to maintain the health, safety, property values, and welfare of our residents and visitors, the Town of Oak Island has ordinances against discarding trash and debris in the right-of-way.

Below is a list (with addresses and phone numbers) for citizens to dispose of brown goods, white goods, electronics and other items that the Town does not pick-up.

In the event your property has trash & debris thrown out at the curb you will receive a notice like this one stating that your property is in violation of one or more of those ordinances. It would also say "This is your first notice of violation; it is intended to inform you so that you can take corrective actions. In the unfortunate event that this letter does not result in compliance with Oak Island's zoning regulations, a second, more formal notice, will be sent explaining how fines will be levied."

The Town of Oak Island operates a convenience site for disposal of brown and white goods and electronics.
