Free Dump Week Events at the Landfill

Brunswick County property owners and residents may bring items, except for household trash and land clearing debris, to the landfill in Bolivia free of charge during Free Week events. Commercial vehicles will be charged normal tipping fees.

Anyone dropping off items must show proof of Brunswick County property ownership or residency. **Brunswick County Landfill, 172 Landfill Rd. NE, Bolivia, NC 28422—September 12, 2016 through September 17, 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.**

Household Hazardous Waste Event

The Brunswick County Solid Waste Department host a household hazardous waste collection event twice each year. During these events items will be taken free of charge from Brunswick County property owners and residents. Anyone dropping off items must show proof of Brunswick County property ownership or residency. Items accepted include non-latex paints, stains, insecticides, herbicides, household cleaners, pool chemicals, and aerosol cans. All items must be labeled. Electronics, latex paints, fluorescent bulbs, automotive fluids, and batteries are NOT accepted during Household Hazardous Waste events; these items can be recycled year round at the Brunswick County Landfill at no charge.
