



Welcome to the Town of Oak Island!

We are so glad you decided to come spend some time with us and we hope you make wonderful memories with your families and friends. There are just a few things we hope you'll keep in mind that will help you have an enjoyable stay.

☀ No glass containers of any kind are allowed on the beach or in beach accesses.

☀ When you're finished for the day, please take all of your beach gear with you – it cannot be left overnight on the beach. Gear and personal items (including chairs and canopy frames) left unattended on the beach between 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m. will be removed and disposed of by the Town of Oak Island.

☀ When you go to the beach with all your beach gear (towels, canopies, chairs, toys, food containers, etc.), please remember that it can't be put on the dunes. Also, your beach gear must be at least 10 feet away from turtle nests and 15 feet away from marked emergency accesses.

☀ Please use only the designated walkways to get to the beach -- please stay off the dunes.

☀ Don't forget to take some sunscreen.

☀ Enjoy your snacks or picnic lunch, but remember to pack up your trash and either take it with you or use one of the cans at the beach accesses.

☀ For the safety of other visitors and sea turtles, fill and level all holes before you leave the beach for the day.

☀ Please put your trash and recycling carts out Friday night so they're ready for early morning collection in areas with Saturday pickups (in beach areas on the summer schedule). Please call our Public Works Department (910) 201-8083 if you have any questions about the pickup schedule.

☀ During the summer months, all dogs must be on a leash **at all times**. Please use a plastic bag to clean up after your pet, and dispose of waste in trash containers.
